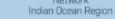

- 5. You can win the Better Hospitality Award and receive support to develop or implement a sustainability project or strategy.



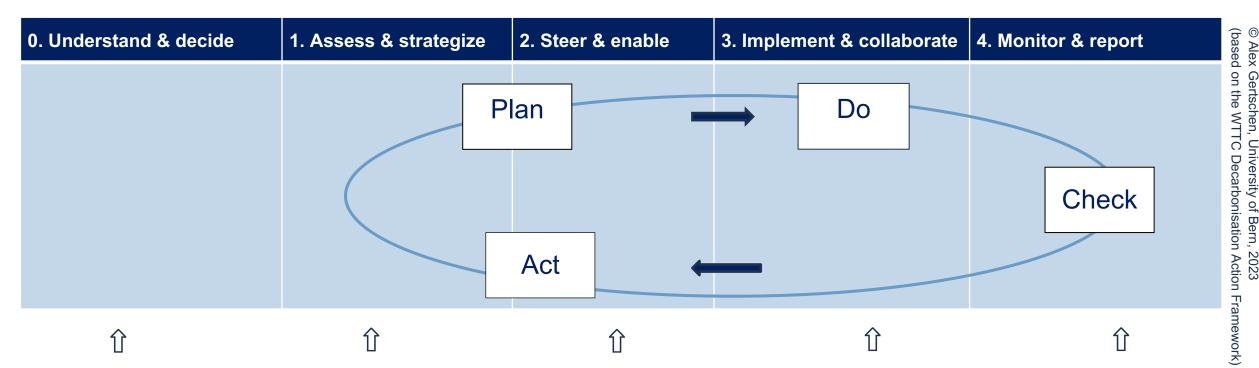

Better Hospitality Award



- The official award of the Better Hospitality Initiative (accessible to BHI participants only)
- Serves to incentivise and guide BHI participants in the development of a sustainability project or strategy
- Does not evaluate and reward what has been done in the past, but the conceptualisation of future transformation (probability and relevance of change)
- Is carried out in the three world regions of the BHI (Asia, Europa & Africa, Latin America), with 3 winners in each world region
- The proposal to be submitted necessarily includes the topic of decarbonisation exclusively or as part of a wider sustainability project or strategy
- The BHA Jury is composed of LLN representatives and the BHI Market Movers



Better Hospitality Award (timeline)

Enterprises interested in the BHA receive advice and support in the context of the regional learning groups	Jan – Apr 2024
Enterprises competing for the BHA submit project or strategy	Apr 2024
Jury (composed of LLN and market movers) takes decision on winning proposals	Apr 2024
9 winning proposals are presented at global closing ceremony	May 2024
9 BHA winners receive one-on-one support by one or several market movers to improve/implement their project or strategy (at least 8hrs in total)	May – Dec 2024
BHA winners present their project or strategy at global closing ceremony of the BHI's 2 nd edition	May 2025

- 1. Credibility and competence of company
- 2. Credibility and competence of team in charge

<u>Proposal</u>

- 1. Potential ecological impact
- 2. Strategic embeddedness in business strategy/model
- 3. Methodology
- 4. Available resources
- 5. Innovativeness
- 6. Potential of replication



Requirements

For all enterprises

- 1. Commitment to the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact
- 2. Participation in 3 out of 4 BHI activities (up to three people can participate on behalf of a company)
- 3. Participation fee:

For winners of the Better Hospitality Award

- Exceptional participation in the BHI activities (e.g., by presenting good practice or consistently commenting on peers' enquiries in the forum)
- 2. Participation in the Better Hospitality Award by submitting an excelling project or strategy to reduce your enterprise's CO₂ emissions or ecological footprint in general.



Inscription procedure

- 2. Select your country category, fill out the form and make the payment
 - \rightarrow Each company only needs **one** registration. You can include up to two additional company representatives for participation, making a **maximum of three** representatives per company.

- 4. In the days following your registration you will receive 5 emails one for each BHI training session day and the review and outlook session during calendar weeks 44 to 48

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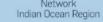










































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
